



# Senior Student Agreement

## **Attendance At St Clare's College all students accept the following attendance guidelines:**

- » I will attend and participate positively in every scheduled lesson
- » I will follow College policies regarding absences from school
- » I will attend all scheduled assemblies, liturgies and other compulsory events
- » I will meet the requirements of the Board of Senior Secondary Studies (BSSS) in relation to attendance (Please note that leave for family holidays will not normally be approved).

## **Work Ethic At St Clare's College all students strive to develop effective work ethic practices by:**

- » I will use my time at school productively
- » I will take responsibility for the completion of assessment items and associated study
- » I will meet the requirements of the Board of Senior Secondary Studies in relation to assessment.

## **Administration At St Clare's College all students accept the following procedures:**

- » I will report to the First Aid Office before leaving the College due to sickness
- » I will complete and check College and Board of Senior Secondary Studies forms as required
- » I will inform parents about relevant College activities, including providing them with correspondence as required
- » I will sign out from Student Administration if leaving the College for a scheduled appointment during the day.

## **Pastoral Care At St Clare's College all students value pastoral care initiatives by agreeing:**

- » I will participate in and be supportive of House and Pastoral activities
- » I will share the responsibility for keeping our College grounds clean
- » I will show positive leadership to younger students.

## **Ethos At St Clare's College all students accept:**

- » I will support the religious, cultural, sporting and social activities of the College
- » I will support the College Leaders and the Student Representative Council.
- » I will display behaviour that respects the reputation of the College within the community
- » I will study at least a Minor in Religious Education.

## **Uniform and Conduct At St Clare's College all students show pride:**

- » I will wear the College uniform correctly
- » I will behave, both in public and at the College, in a manner creditable to the College and myself
- » I will be sensitive to the rights of everyone who works and lives in the vicinity of the College
- » I will project a positive image of the College whenever in uniform
- » I will follow rules in regards to visitors
- » I will follow rules in regards to use of mobile phones and electronic equipment
- » I accept that smoking in College uniform is prohibited at all times
- » I accept that possession and/or use of alcohol or illicit drugs is unacceptable behaviour
- » If driving to school, I will use designated parking areas, obey speed limits around the College, accept responsibility for any damage caused while driving, carry as passengers only those students who have parental permission to be in my car, exercise care and attention while driving and obey road rules and courtesies.

## **Senior Focus/Study Day At St Clare's College all students acknowledge the privilege and opportunity:**

- » I will return a signed permission note from my parent/guardian to study off site on timetabled Study Days
- » I will consult the College calendar to confirm when I am required to attend a Focus Day
- » When I choose to attend the College on a Study Day, I will wear College uniform, follow all normal College expectations, work in the allocated study areas only and sign in and out via Student Administration
- » I will only use Clare Lawn for recess and lunch breaks
- » If I require support from a teacher during a Study Day, I will email the teacher prior to arrange an appointment.
