Who can participate?

All current students enrolled at St Clares College are welcome to join the program.

What is involved weekly?

- 1. Your student will have a weekly lesson with Julia at St Clares. The lessons will be in a group format but no larger than 4 students per lesson. Lessons are 45 min per week during school hours.
- 2. Students will also participate in an ensemble run by Julia at St Clares. Time and day TBA. Weekly 45 min ensemble lesson where students can learn to play in an orchestra and socialise with the other students in the program. The ensemble will seek performance opportunities within the school community to showcase the students progress and skills.
